CONSIDERATIONS REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL PERFORMANCE FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE SUSTAINABILITY

Abstract

Analysis of the impact of economic performance is largely based on the competitiveness of agriculture. This creates an important step in identifying opportunities, challenges and proactive measures in the revised projection of functional agricultural productivity in terms of environmental sustainability. The purpose of this study is to investigate the indicators through the evolution of the effects on the agricultural economy as a result of the new reporting agreed in the common agricultural policy considered by the authors as environmental conditions and how they lead to effects reflected in the Gross Domestic Product. The working method is based on the exploitation of historical data, followed by the anticipation of their interdependence.
