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APPLICATIONS OF ADSORPTION ONTO DOWEX-MARATHON ANIONIC RESIN: A REVIEW

Recovery processes such as the separation of carboxylic acids, vanillin, citric and lactic acids, as well as precious and rare metals like palladium and gold, are highlighted, demonstrating the resin's potential for resource recovery and circular economy practices. Furthermore, studies on isotope enrichment, particularly for uranium and molybdenum, underscore its applicability in nuclear and industrial fields. The review also covers modified forms of Dowex-Marathon resin, such as those embedded with zirconium molybdate or iron oxide nanoparticles, which exhibit significantly enhanced adsorption capacities and selectivity for contaminants like arsenic and phosphate. Overall, this paper aims to support researchers and practitioners seeking an accessible, cost-effective, and efficient adsorbent material.
