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CURRICULAR DEVELOPMENT PERSPECTIVES: EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Abstract

The paper considers the issue of education for sustainable development from both the theoretical and practical standpoints. The theoretical approach points out that education for sustainable development starts from the early years of the individual's life, the first educational factor being the family.
